Question 1: Can you share how Broadcom collects and integrates user feedback into the development of the Layer7 API Gateway? We're interested in understanding the recent changes that have been influenced by customer input, particularly in the context of our municipality as a customer of Enable U.

Answer: The Broadcom teams works with direct customers and partners to get feedback on what features and capabilities we will build. We share this on calls and the community site to get feedback and ask for inputs. In particular for Enable-U we hold partner calls during each PI phase, to share what we are planning to do in the next PI. I am interested to know what 'recent changes' the question is about.

#### Question 2: Are there any plans to publish workshop videos for using Graphman?

Answer: Regarding the Graphman workshops: more people are interested and we are investigating how and where to organise this. We are also looking for municipalities who would like to host this. We will keep you posted!

Broadcom also has a number of session on the community (office hours replays) and content in the IMS academy.



Question 3: Graphman is very powerful, and we are very interested in automating the deployment of services from non-production to production environments. Some instruction video's would be appreciated.

Question 6: Great initiative, but like Aron said earlier...ensure the basics are implemented... schema validations, rate limiting...et cetera.

Can you share the best practices of security measures all the Enable U customers should apply in their API Gateway.... before they take security to the next level with ML/AI with (or without) Salt. Obviously implementing the next level of security is just a matter of time.

Answer: Hi, as you will understand, this is a topic that's bigger than what we can cover today. We are working on this internally in Enable U as we speak and will communicate this in the near future with our L7 Gateway customers. And especially with the attendees of this session of course. Question 7: How does Salt Security integrate with existing incident management systems like SIEM or SOAR platforms in conjunction with Layer??

Answer: We hook up salt security via a workflow system, to enable remediation / logging back to the gateway or any kind of other integration with other logging mechanisms or SIEM/SOC tools.
